Mr. Tsering Angchok was born on 26.02.1957 in village Hunder Nubra, Leh district. He had his schooling from Sainik School Balachadi, Jamnagar Gujarat. He did his graduation and post graduation in history from Kashmir University. In 1984 he qualified the Combined Competitive Service




Examination and was inducted in KAS in 1997. Then in Indian Administrative Service in 2013 with 2002 as the year allotment. He was promoted to selection Grade IAS in January 2015.

He served in various capacities in the State Service as Under Secretary to Government Planning & Development, Forest and Higher Education Department. Then as Dy. Secretary to Government Planning Department and Dy. Secretary to Governor during Governor's Rule. As Additional Dy. Commissioner Leh he facilitated the smooth arrangement of porters for the Indian Army during Kargil

War in 1999 and also arranged Volunteers from the villages for carrying war materials and essential items to the border areas. As Joint Director Industries Jammu handled the compilation and preparation of Industrial policy 2004 and streamlined the price preferences to the SSI Units in the purchases being affected for the government departments. As Director IREP installed seven Micro Mini Flour Mills with 20 watt Electricity generation in 07 districts and two Micro Hydel Projects in Ladakh region in collaboration with NGOs. He also introduced the concept of CFL Energy lights distribution to the villagers on pilot basis.

During his significant assignment as Deputy Commissioner Leh efficiently handled the flash flood of 2010 in Leh district. In record time of 12 hours a make shift hospital was established with 80 indoor patients as the existing SNM Hospital was flooded. On war footing most of the roads was temporarily restored in two days time in the after math of flood. Relief & Rehabilitation of 800 families were arranged. Implemented PM's Package by creating one room tenement prefab huts to more than 450 families with the help of a government of India undertaking. In a record time, 03 settlement colonies were established within a period of six months in Choglamsar Housing Colony, Palam and near Mani Ringmo Leh. Arranged in evacuating 200 foreign tourists through Indian Air force Helicopters from the flood affected areas. In 2011, Leh town was brought to its pristine glory. On

this account the PMO has appreciated the district administration Leh for maintaining highest degree of transparency and quick rehabilitation of affected families. As DC Leh acquired more than 100 Kanals of land for promotion of tourism in leh district for Himalayan cultural centre, food craft centre and 18 holes Golf ground near Sindhu Garh Leh. Five new Blocks of SNM hospital was initiated and started the work out of PMs package fund and MPlad funds. Major roads and bridges were also reconstructed. Smooth coordination and monitoring of exgratia relief to 300 death cases and reconstruction of 700 affected families were implemented in time bound banner. District Disaster Management Plan for Leh district was framed and prepared in consultation with the NDMA GOI. Then the Chief Minister of J&K appreciated the role of Mr. Angchok in handling the flood 2010 in a most professional and transparent manner in a meeting with Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council in 2011. In the last stint of his career he served as Excise Commissioner J&K, and conceptualized and created the social responsibility funds in the excise department for drive against drug addiction, drunken driving and mass awareness among the school children through print & electronic media regarding ill effects of drugs. Brought transparency by introducing E- Payment with the help of J&K Bank for the revenue receipts of the Excise department which was highly appreciated by the finance minster J&K. He superannuated on 28 .02.2017.



For his distinguished service in the State government for more than 32 years and for his impeccable integrity Mr. Tsering Angchok was appointed as Member of Public Service Commission on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2017.
