I M P O R T A N T

- The Commission have developed an electronically scannable Application Form for the J&K Civil Service (Judicial) Examination, which is processed on computerized machines. This Application Form, instructions for filling up the Application Form, Acknowledgement Card and an Envelope for submitting the Application Form, will be available at the Commission Offices at Resham Ghar Colony, Bakshi Nagar, Jammu/Polo Ground, Srinagar from **20.03.2012**.
- Syllabus for the Civil Service (Judicial) Examination is attached and can also be downloaded from the website of the Commission viz. www.jkpsc.org.
- Candidates are advised to go through the instructions and all the eligibility conditions prescribed for the examination before filling in the Application Form.
- Last date for receipt of Application Forms, complete in all respects, in the Commission offices indicated above, is **20.04.2012**.
- Candidates are advised not to wait till the last date. They are advised to submit their Application Forms complete in all respects at the earliest so that it reaches the Commission office in time.
- The candidates are further advised to attach all the necessary documents, as required with the Application Form.
- The Commission will not be responsible for any postal/courier delays and any Application Form received after the above prescribed last date, shall not be entertained.

Whereas, the Government Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs vide letter No: LD(A)201/70 dated: 01.12.2011 referred 10 permanent vacancies of Civil Judge(Junior Division)/Munsiffs in the Subordinate Judiciary to J&K Public Service Commission for selection out of the eligible Candidates through competitive Examination; and

Whereas, these vacancies were advertised by the Public Service Commission vide advertisement Notification No: PSC/EXAM/2011/139 Dated: 10.12.2011, as per the following break up provided by the Administrative Department:-

Whereas, the Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs vide their referral letter No: LD(A) 2011/70 Dated:14.03.2012 referred 28 more temporary vacancies of Civil Judge (Junior Division)/Munsiffs in the Subordinate Judiciary for

being filled up through competitive Examination. The breakup of these vacancies as referred by the Administrative Department is as under:-

Whereas, while referring these vacancies, the Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs has incorporated the following stipulation:-

"It is also requested that the Selection process may be initiated immediately and examination etc. be clubbed with the already referred 10 posts of Civil Judge (Junior Division)/ Munsiffs."

The matter has been examined in the Public Service Commission and in view of the above quoted Law Departments stipulation, it is hereby notified as under:

1. The number of vacancies as notified in advertisement notification No: PSC/EXAM/2011/139 Dated: 10.12.2011 shall be recast as under:-

2. The interested candidates who are permanent resident of J&K State as defined in Section 6 of the Constitution who did not apply for the posts notified vide Notification No. PSC/EXAM/2011/139 Dated: 10.12.2011 can now apply against the above mentioned posts as mentioned in para 1.
3. The applications forms shall be available at the Commission office at Resham Grah Colony, Bakshi Nagar, Jammu and Polo Ground, Srinagar w.e.f 20.03.2012. The last date for receipt of application forms complete in all respects in the commissions office indicated above shall be 20.04.2012.
4. The Examination fee of Rs.700/- (Rs.350/- for reserved categories) (Excluding the processing charges of Rs.10/-) to be paid in cash through the counters of J&K Bank opened in PSC offices, Jammu/Srinagar.
5. The candidates who have already applied need not apply again.
6. The eligibility for the posts with respect to age shall be determined as on 1st January, 2011 and shall be **minimum 18 years and maximum 35 years.**

7. The eligibility with respect to qualification shall be the last date for receipt of applications which is 20.04.2012. for the benefit of candidates the qualification for the posts is as under:

A Bachelor of Laws of a University established by Law in India;

OR

A Barrister of England or Northern Ireland or a member of the faculty of Advocates in Scotland or holding any other equivalent law degree recognized by the Government of India.

8. The Commission shall conduct competitive examination for the posts mentioned above in accordance with rules laid down vide SRO 5 dated: 04.01.1968 as amended from time to time read with the J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examination) Rules 2005.
9. The details of scheme of examination shall be the same as notified vide Notification No. PSC/EXAM/2011/139 Dated: 10.12.2011.
10. The other conditions not mentioned hereinabove shall be the same as contained in PSC/EXAM/2011/139 Dated: 10.12.2011. However, for facilitation of the candidates, the syllabus and other details of scheme of examination shall be available on the commissions website www.jkpsc.org and www.jkpsc.nic.in.
11. Copy of the Notification No. PSC/EXAM/2011/139 Dated: 10.12.2011 shall also be available on the Commissions website.
12. The candidates shall submit the original application form duly filled in. however, they shall attach the following documents while submitting the application form with the photocopy of the application:
- Matriculate or Secondary School certificate as proof of date of birth;
 - University certificates showing that he holds requisite minimum educational qualification as prescribed;
 - Certificates of good character from the Principal of the College last attended and from two responsible persons of status (not relatives), who are well acquainted with him in private life, and are unconnected with his university, College or School life;
 - Permanent Resident Certificate; and
 - Category certificate, if any, issued under SRO 294 of 2005 dated 21.10.2005 duly revalidated and valid on the last date of receipt of Application Form.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Candidate(s) should fill up the Application Form(s) carefully.
- No column of Application Form should be left blank.
- Incomplete and incorrectly filled in Application Form shall not be entertained. No representation or correspondence regarding such rejection shall be entertained.**
- The candidate(s) should also note that their admission at all the stages of examination shall be provisional, subject to fulfillment of the prescribed eligibility conditions.**
- If it comes to the notice of the Commission at any time before or after the Main Examination, or Interview, that a candidate does not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions or the candidate has claimed eligibility based on misrepresentation, fraud or concealment of material fact or

impersonation, his/her candidature for the examination shall be cancelled and he/she shall be also liable for prosecution/disciplinary action by the Commission which includes debarment from appearing in the future examinations.

6. Any change of address given in the Application Form should at once be communicated to the Secretary, J&K Public Service Commission.
7. Candidates must be in sound bodily health. They must, if selected, be prepared to undergo such medical examination and satisfy such medical authority, as the Government may require.
8. Canvassing, in any form, shall disqualify a candidate.

ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT.

Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information. While filling in the Application Forms, candidates are also warned that they should, in no case, alter or otherwise temper with any entry in a document or its attested/certified copy submitted by them, nor should they submit a tampered/fabricated document. If there is any inaccuracy or discrepancy between two or more such documents or their attested /certified copies, an explanation regarding this discrepancy should be furnished.

A candidate who is, or has been, declared by the Commission, to be guilty of:

- i. obtaining by wrongful support of his/her candidature by any means, or
- ii. impersonating, or
- iii. procuring impersonation by any person, or
- iv. submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with or
- v. making statements which are incorrect, or false or suppressing material information or
- vi. resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the selection, or
- vii. using unfair means during the test, or
- viii. writing irrelevant matter including obscene language or pornographic matter, in the script (s), or
- ix. misbehaving in any other manner in the examination hall, or
- x. harassing or doing bodily harm to the staff employed by the Commission for the conduct of their test, or
- xi. attempting to commit or, as the case may be, abetting the Commission of all or any of the acts specified in the foregoing clauses may, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable;

(a) to be disqualified by the Commission from selection for which he/she is a candidate, and/or

(b) to be debarred either permanently or for a specified period:-

- (i) By the Commission from any examination or selection held by them.
- (ii) By the State Government from any employment under them, and

(c) if he/she is already in service under Government, disciplinary action can be taken against him/her under the appropriate rules.

IMPORTANT

1. Candidate must read the detailed instructions for the candidates before filling up of the form. He/she must fill the form strictly according to the instructions.
2. Candidates must ensure that no column is left blank or is wrongly filled, as information furnished therein would be used for deciding the eligibility and suitability of the candidate for being called for the interview. Application Form not filled in correctly and as per the instructions is liable to be rejected and the onus of such rejection shall be on the candidate himself/herself. The Commission shall not entertain any claim in respect of such rejection.
