Whereas, in response to the aforesaid Notices, only two candidates viz., Ms. Anupama Kumari and Ms. Bint Ul Zehra submitted appeals/representations against their rejection, whileas the other candidates did not submit any response within the stipulated time; and,


Whereas, the appeals/representations submitted by the above-mentioned candidates, namely, Ms. Anupama Kumari and Ms. Bint Ul Zehra were placed before the Appellate Authority of the Commission for consideration; and,

Whereas, the Appellate Authority examined the appeals/applications of the candidate and decided as under:-

S.No.	Name of the candidate	Roll No.	Reasons of the rejection
1	Ms. Anupam Kumari	5302030	On perusal of the available records it transpires that the candidate was not in possession of valid SLC category certificate on cut-off date, as per format prescribed under J&K Reservation Rules. As regards, the request of the appellant to settle her case on the analogy of the case of Abdul Majid for the post of lecturer Education, the Appellate Authority is of the view that the analogy is not applicable in the instant case as

			<p>the ST & SC certificates are issued on the basis of birth, the status of the same cannot change over the period of time. However, in case of the other categories including SLC/OBC, the status can change at any time. Besides, the Advertisement Notification issued by J&K PSC expressly mentions that the candidate must possess valid category certificate on the cut-off date as per the format prescribed under Reservation Rules 2005 of UT of J&K.</p> <p>Keeping in view the above facts, the Appellate Authority is of the opinion that the appeal does not hold merit and is accordingly dismissed.</p>
2	Bint Ul Zehra	5302030	<p>"On perusal of the available records and documents submitted by the appellant, it is established that the appellant was not in possession of valid EWS certificate on cut-off date i.e. 09.01.2025. Besides, the Advertisement Notification issued by J&K PSC expressly mentions that the candidate must possess valid category certificate on the cut-off date as per the format prescribed under Reservation Rules 2005 of UT of J&K.</p> <p>Keeping in view the above facts, the Appellate Authority is of the opinion that the appeal does not hold merit and is accordingly dismissed."</p>

In light of the above, the candidature of all the seven candidates detailed in the table at para 1 above is hereby rejected for the post of Lecturer Chemistry in School Education Department.
